

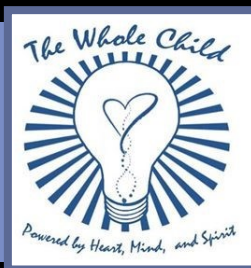

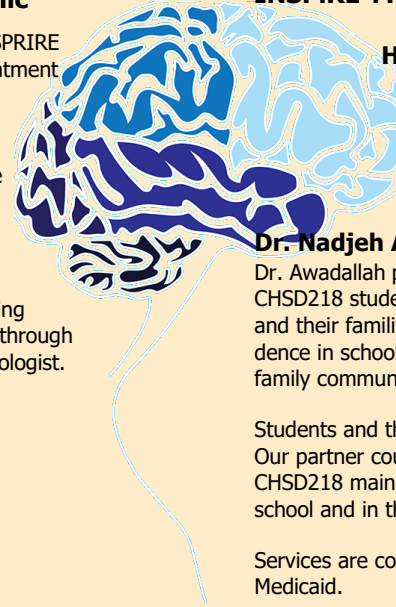

INSPIRE Neuropsychology Clinic

The Neuropsychology branch of the INSPiRE Clinic specializes in assessment and treatment of the brain.

Assessments are conducted by licensed clinical child psychologists with extensive training in child neuropsychology and school psychology.

Assessment includes a psychological evaluation assessment of thinking, learning and academic skills. These services are through referral of the child's home school psychologist.

Hartgrove Counseling

Individual and family counseling services are provided through Hartgrove Counseling. Hartgrove is a well established mental health service resource in the Chicago area.

Dr. Nadjeh Awadallah

Dr. Awadallah provides individual and/or family counseling for CHSD218 students and their families. He has worked with students and their families successfully teaching strategies in building confidence in school and social situations, overcoming anxiety, improving family communication.

Students and their families can call directly to make appointments. Our partner counseling offices are located at various each of the CHSD218 main high school buildings. Sessions are available after-school and in the evening.

Services are covered by most medical insurances, including Medicaid.

HOW TO REFER TO INSPiRE

Students in CHSD218 and Partner Cooperatives:

Services are free to in-district students. A referral can be made by a school psychologist or building administrator. If you would like to inquire about our services, please contact your school psychologist or contact us directly at (708) 572-9425.

Students who attend outside of CHSD218:

Students and parents requesting Independent Educational Evaluations can contact us directly at (708) 572-9425. INSPiRE staff will assist in referring to appropriate independent providers of neuropsychological assessments who accepts most medical insurance plans. These types of referrals are subject to the general fee schedule as outline below:

Neuropsychoevaluational assessment & Report	\$1,500/per
(up to 20 hours of service)	
Post assessment feedback session	\$ 300/per
(with guardians or schools)	
Additional Hours and Follow-Up Services	\$ 75/hr
(counseling, consultations and additional assessments)	
Mileage	\$ 0.54/mile
